When researchers accounted for the time between diagnosis and surgery for women who got operations, and also for how long women with cataracts survived when they didn't get surgery, the cataract surgery was now associated with a higher risk of death from all causes.

"With this factor, it appears that not having surgery (is associated with) longer life, but it is not a cause-and-effect relationship," said Coleman of the David Geffen School. — Reuters

extended period to evolve, and because the light and heat on planets can change as their stars age, scientists usually look for planets that have both some water and some way to keep their climates stable over time.

Kite, and Eric Ford from Penn State set up a simulation with thousands of randomly generated planets, and tracked the evolution of their climates over billions of years.

"The surprise was that many of them stay stable for more than a billion years, just by luck of the draw," Kite said.

"Our best guess is that it's on the order of 10 per cent of them," he said.

These lucky planets sit in the right location around their stars.

Even if a message does get through, that may be the most the rover — mute since June 10 — can muster. Even before the dust storm, the 15-year-old rover was exhibiting signs of old age. Its front steering and flash memory are shot.

"We are pulling for our tenacious rover to pull her feet from the fire one more time," project manager John Callas said in a statement from Nasa's Jet Propulsion Laboratory in Pasadena, California.

Opportunity's twin, Spirit, got stuck in soft Martian dirt in 2009, and NASA eventually gave up trying to free it.

Both rovers were designed to operate for just 90 days, however, and exceeded expectations.

They were launched separately in 2003 and landed on Mars in 2004.
